Blossoming Buds needs to know of all the possible people who may be picking up your child. Please leave the person's name, relation, and phone number on the lines provided. We need to know, **in person**, when someone, other than the parents, is picking up your child. We **will not** let anyone else pick up your child under any circumstances. We will need to see picture ID from anyone different than the parents picking up the child. This is all for the safety of your child.

### **Enrolling at Blossoming Buds Preschool Summer Camps**

- A. Blossoming Buds does not reimburse money for days/weeks that are missed regarding sickness, holidays, etc.
- B. Returned checks will result in a \$25.00 service fee.
- C. Students that are not potty trained are charged **\$25/week** session.

### **Hours of Operation for Blossoming Buds and Pick-up/drop-off Rules**

- A. Blossoming Buds Preschool will be open from 9:00am-1:00pm Monday thru Friday.
- B. At 9:00am a teacher will open the school doors and greet the waiting students. At this time you may choose to escort your child to their cubby or we will bring them in for you.
- C. Please do not park in the driveway and load/un-load zone if you want to bring your student in the school.
- D. It is really important for the children to be picked up on time at 1pm.
- E. There will be a \$5.00 charge for the first 10 minutes late, a dollar for every minute after the first 10 minutes. Late fee will be collect the next camp day.
- F. When school is over we will get the children ready to go and will excuse them as soon as we see you outside.

### **Health Policies**

#### **Illness Policy**

Please be considerate of the other families and keep ill children at home. Use your best judgment. If a child comes to Blossoming Buds and has a temperature, rash, drainage from the eye, diarrhea, vomiting, sore throat, severe cough, severe headache, etc the parents will be contacted immediately to pick-up their child. Germs can spread fast in a preschool even though we sanitize daily and when needed hourly.

When unsure please feel free to contact your teacher and she will let you know what to do. Blossoming Buds will never give children medication that was not brought by the parents. If a child is sick and the doctor has given the parents permission that it is safe for the child to come back to preschool we will give the child medication if needed. Please bring the medication and the dosage and we will make sure to give the child the right amount at the right time.

Please note that most children, when sick, are not contagious after 3 days, but if the child still has a lot of symptoms (coughing, severe running nose, sneezing, tired, nauseous, etc.) we ask them not to be brought to preschool. Once the child has a little bit of a running nose that is when it is safe to bring them back. Thank you for understanding.

#### **Hand Washing Policy**

The children and staff will be required to wash their hands before eating anything and after using the restroom. Blossoming Buds will have sanitation wipes and gel around the facility to make sure the children and staff always has access to cleaning their hands/face.

#### **Medication/Allergy Information**

If your child has any medical problem that may need attention while in Blossoming Buds care we highly advise the parents to keep an extra set of medication with us. We will keep the medication in a locked box that will only be used on your child. For the child's safety, we do not allow the medication to be stored in the child's cubby. Please write down any medical problems your child has on the lines provided and turn it in.

## **Important General Information for Blossoming Buds**

### Snack/Lunch

Please bring a health snack, lunch and water bottle for your child each day. Health snacks include: a fruit/veggie along with some crackers, string cheese, small yogurt, turkey slices, etc. Please put their 2 items for snack in separate bag from their lunch and label with their name and “snack.”

### Clothing

Please make sure your child comes prepared in the appropriate attire every day. We will be doing a lot of arts and crafts and other activities that may cause them to get dirty. Blossoming Buds is not responsible for any clothing that gets ruined under our supervision. Also be aware of the weather and dress them accordingly. We highly suggest leaving an extra outfit and underwear in their backpack just in case of an accident or spill. During the summer program we will be spending a lot of time outside so please protect them from getting sunburned: sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, etc.

**\*\*Please no tie-shoes**

**\*\*Please bring a full-size back pack each day that all of their belongs can fit in**

**\*\* Very important: label water bottle, backpack, lunch bag, etc**

### Communication

The week before your camp starts, you will receive an email from your teacher about what they students will be doing during their week of camp. This email will also include reminders on what needs to be brought each day to camp. Feel free to email your teacher at that time with any questions you have.

### Child Abuse Reporting Law Requirements

By law we are required to report any indication of child abuse, being emotional, physical, sexual abuse, child neglect or exploitation. The director, Tristan Christophilis, has taken classes on child abuse and knows the direct signs of any abuse. The director would not hesitate to contact CPS if any of the signs are visible. Abuse is a major issue and will be taken very seriously.

We are not obligated to inform parents if the police or CPS is notified.
